Application under Section 5 of the Limitation Act for
condonation of delay of 43 days in filing the appeal has been filed.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, same is allowed and
delay of 43 days in filing the appeal is condoned.

Application stands disposed of.

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As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants,
learned counsel and representative of the respondent-Insurance Company
(separately recorded), a sum of ₹ 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lac Only) over and
above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full
and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of
learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellants
in proportion as already awarded by the MACT.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the
Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for ₹ 2,00,000/- in the name
of appellants in proportion as already awarded by the MACT with the office of
the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of six weeks from today, in
compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9 % per annum shall follow

on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be consigned to the record room.
