1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari challenging the order dated 16.10.1996 (Annexure P-1), vide which, petitioner No.1 has been reverted to the post of Constable and the order dated 03.09.1996 (Annexure P-7), vide which, petitioner No.2 has been reverted to the post of Constable. Other prayers have also been made in the present writ petition.
2. Learned State Counsel has submitted that in the present petition, no stay has been granted in favour of the petitioners and the matter is of the year 1997 and in all probability, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. Today, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners in order to rebut the abovesaid aspect.
4. Accordingly, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
5. Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioners to move an application for restoration of the present case or to file a fresh petition, in case, any cause survives to them.
6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
