1. In this revision petition, the petitioners assail the correctness of trial Court's order closing his evidence. In substance the petitioners pray for one opportunity. The petitioners herein are the plaintiffs. They have filed a suit for possession by way of specific performance of the agreement to sell with respect to 19 kanals 10 marlas land.

2. The petitioner No.1, Gurmit Singh has also tendered his affidavit in lieu of his deposition in examination-in-chief. He has also been partly cross-examined. However, his further cross-examination was deferred for want of some documents. Subsequently, the petitioner failed to appear, which resulted in impugned order.

3. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, this Court is of the considered view that the interest of justice would be served if the petitioner No.1 is granted opportunity to appear before the trial Court so

as to enable the learned counsel representing the defendant to complete his cross-examination.

4. The revision petition is allowed.
