JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent No. 2 to release her passport which has been retained on account of directions of Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala.
2. Mr. Amit Sharma, Senior Panel Counsel submits that Passport Authority has already issued passport, however, it is lying in its custody.
3. Mr. Pawan Kumar, DAG, Punjab, at the outset submits that police after completing investigation has filed its report in FIR No. 29 dated 07.02.2022 under Sections 323, 354, 506, 34 of IPC and 3 (1) of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 registered at Police Station Tripri, Patiala.
4. The petition stands disposed of with liberty to petitioner to seek permission of trial Court as and when she wants to travel abroad.
