The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to release the pending retiral benefits of the petitioner along with interest @ 18% per annum from the due date i.e. 01.06.2018 till the date of actual payment.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has unfortunately died. He has instructions from the wife of the petitioner that all the retiral benefits have been released by the respondents and she does not want to further pursue the present petition.
