1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner intended to apply in the Economically Weaker Section in response to the Advertisement No. 3 of 2023 dated 07.03.2023 appended as Annexure P-1 by which, various Group C posts were advertised.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that despite repeated request that the petitioner's category which was wrongly mentioned while filling up the form, no action is being taken by the respondents hence, such act on the part of respondents is totally arbitrary and illegal therefore, the petitioner has approached this Court with the direction that the petitioner's claim under various categories in which the petitioner has applied for, be considered under the Economically Weaker Section.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the grievance raised in the present writ petition, has already been raised by the petitioner through a representation dated 16.12.2023 (Annexure P-7) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, the representation dated 16.12.2023 (Annexure P-7) has been received and is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the authorities concerned within a period of four weeks from the date of the receipt of copy of this order.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
