HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. By this common order, six writ petitions, the details of which have been given in the heading, are being disposed of as all these petitions involve the same question of law on similar facts.

2. In the present bunch of petitions, the claim of the petitioners is for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners for promotion to the post of Hindi Master/Mistress keeping in view the that employees junior to the petitioners have already been granted the said benefit, the details of the juniors, have been given in the writ petitions.

3. Though, reply to the petitions has not been filed by the State but learned counsel for the respondents, on the instructions from Mr. Rajiv Kumar, Sr. Assistant, O/o D.S.E (S), Punjab, submits that the claim of each of the petitioner in the present bunch of petitions will be examined for promotion to the post of Master/Mistress keeping in view allegation that the juniors to the petitioners have already been promoted and in case, after

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consideration, it is found that any junior of the petitioner is promoted, appropriate decision will be taken either to promote the petitioners or to revert the juniors. In case, the decision is taken by the State to promote the petitioners, they will be promoted w.e.f the date the juniors have been promoted and the required benefit admissible to the petitioners will be given but in case, the State decides to revert the juniors in case they have wrongly been promoted, appropriate decision will be taken by giving due show cause notice to the said juniors and the said consideration will be completed within a period of eight weeks.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petitions may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

5. Ordered accordingly.

6. Civil miscellaneous application pending if any, also stands disposed of.
