1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner/complainant under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the learned trial Court to dispose of criminal case having FIR No.46 dated 29.01.2015 registered under Sections 406, 420, 506, 120-B of IPC at Police Station Ballabhgarh, City, District Faridabad, in a time bound manner.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is 70 years of age and that the accused is unnecessarily delaying the proceedings before the trial Court on one pretext or the other and the charges in this case were framed on 05.07.2018 and till date trial Court is able to partly examine PW-1 i.e. petitioner-Rajbir Singh.
3. Notice of motion
4. Mr. Neeraj Sheoran, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State and has not refuted the aforesaid factual matrix as has been brought to the notice of this Court by the counsel for the petitioner and further apprised the Court that application filed by the prosecution under Section 319 Cr.P.C. is pending for its disposal before the trial Court and the next date fixed is 22.04.2024.

5. In view of the fact that charges were framed in the present case is 05.07.2018 and that petitioner/complainant is a senior citizen aged about 70 years, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the trial Court is hereby directed to dispose of application, if any, filed by the prosecution/complainant under Section 319 Cr.P.C., at the earliest without granting unnecessary adjournments and for that purpose if need be the trial Court is at liberty to prepone the case from 22.04.2024 to some earlier date in the month of February and thereafter to proceed ahead with the trial, in accordance with law and to dispose of the trial expeditiously.

6. The present petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
