Through the instant petition, under Section 482 Cr.P.C, prayer is made for quashing of the P.O. order dated 24.03.2021, passed by the learned PCS, Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga (Annexure P-3), in case FIR No.54 dated 11.03.2020, under Sections 420 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga, Punjab.
