Petitioner is facing trial in a case arising out of FIR No.1083 dated 08.12.2022 registered under Section 302 of the IPC registered at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa in the Court of learned Sessions Judge, Sirsa.

2. By way of this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner is to grant him interim bail for 03 days so as to attend the Bhog ceremony of his father-in-law who has expired on 21.01.2024. However before this Court learned counsel for the petitioner has made a prayer that petitioner may be taken in custody to the venue of the Bhog ceremony of his father-in-law, which is to taken place on 02.02.2024.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Parveen Kumar Aggarwal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent- State.

5. Learned State counsel has no objection to the aforesaid prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

6. Petitioner is stated to be confined in District Jail, Sirsa. Bhog ceremony is to take place at Ganesh Colony, Near Samadha Mandir, Hansi (District Hisar), as per Bhog card (Annexure P-1).
7. As such this petition is hereby disposed of with the direction to the Superintendent District Jail, Sirsa to make necessary arrangement to take the petitioner on 02.02.2024 to the place of venue of the Bhog ceremony of the father-in-law of the petitioner in Hansi and after the ceremony is over, to confine him back in the jail, on the same day.
8. SSP Sirsa will provide the necessary security. Necessary expenses shall be borne by the petitioner.
