On 05.02.2024, the following order was passed in this case:-

“The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the impugned order dated 15.06.2023 (Annexure P-5) vide which the bail granted to the petitioner had been cancelled and non-bailable warrants had been issued against him and for setting aside the order dated 27.10.2023 (Annexure P-6) vide which the petitioner had been declared a proclaimed person in complaint No.NACT/164/2021 dated 19.10.2021 titled as ‘The Lehragaga Primary Co-operative Agriculture Development Bank Limited Branch Lehragaga, District Sangrur through its Branch Manager Bhupinder Khurana versus Parwati Devi’.

The learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner is ready and willing to make the entire payment alongwith the interest thereon to the complainant-Bank.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today and subject to a deposit of Rs.25,000/- as costs with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association, Chandigarh, Account No.65035682434, SBI High Court Branch, IFSC:- SBIN0050306, she shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.

A copy of the receipt depositing a sum of Rs.25,000/- with the aforesaid Association as well as a copy of the order granting interim bail to the petitioner be produced in the Court on the next date of hearing”.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in deference to the aforementioned order, the petitioner has surrendered before the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Moonak and has since been released on bail vide order dated 09.02.2024. A copy thereof is taken on record as Mark ‘A’.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. Disposed of.

It is expected that the petitioner shall henceforth not absent himself from the Trial but for a sufficient cause.
