NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for claiming the following relief :-

“1. That the respondents may be directed to produce the entire record of the case especially regarding the post of Financial Controller, Financial Consultant, Paddy scam files 1994-95.

2. A writ in the nature of certiorari be issued for quashing the wholly illegal impugned order Annexure P-11.

3. A writ in the nature of mandamus be issued directing the respondent No.3 to issue promotion order of the petitioner for the post of Financial Controller.

4. A writ in the nature of mandamus be issued directing the respondent No.3 to maintain status quo to the present post of the petitioner as well as to the post of Financial Controller; during the pendency of writ petition.



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5. A writ in the nature of mandamus be issued directing the respondents to provide necessary protection to the petitioner.”
2. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for respondents No.3 and 4 has produced copy of email sent by the Markfed to learned counsel for respondents No.3 and 4, wherein it has been stated that the petitioner-G.S. Virk already stood retired from service w.e.f. 31.05.2000 and as regard to the post of Financial Controller, it has been stated that no such post exists as per the Markfed Common Cadre Rules. Copy of the email is taken on record.
5. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-proseuction, however, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the same, if any cause still survives.
