1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for issuance of appropriate directions to respondent No.3 to record the statement of the petitioner regarding the incident occurred on 9.11.2019 qua which FIR No.287 dated 9.11.2019 under Section 336 IPC has been registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar.
2. The grievance of the petitioner is that the FIR (supra) should have been registered under Section 307 IPC, instead of Section 336 IPC, as the accused in the above mentioned FIR, not only opened indiscriminate fire but also fired with an intention to kill the present petitioner.
3. It is not in dispute that after completion of investigation, final report has already been filed and the matter is pending before the learned trial Court concerned. The petitioner without availing the alternate remedy has straightway approached this Court for issuance of

directions (supra) and that too after two years of the registration of the FIR. Since the petitioner has an alternate remedy, therefore, this Court is not inclined to pass the asked for direction upon the official concerned and the instant petition is, hereby, **dismissed** with liberty to the petitioner to raise all such pleas, as raised before this Court, before an appropriate forum/Court by making an appropriate motion.

4. **Disposed** of accordingly.
