**KULDEEP TIWARI. J.(Oral)**

1. Through the instant petition, filed for quashing of the FIR bearing No.71, dated 06.06.2015, under Sections 279, 337, 427 and 304-A of the IPC, registered at Police Station Shambhu Patiala, and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of a compromise deed dated 16.08.2021 (Annexure P-2)
2. In view of a judgment rendered by a larger bench of this court in “**Baldev Singh vs. State of Punjab**”, 2016 SCC Online P&H **4509**, to the effect that an FIR registered for the commission of an offence punishable under Section 304-A IPC, cannot be quashed on the basis of compromise.

3. Faced with the above difficulty, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the instant petition, with the liberty to raise all such pleas, as raised through the instant petition, before the learned trial Court concerned, at an appropriate stage.

4. **Dismissed as withdrawn** with the aforesaid liberty.

5. At this stage, it is further informed by the learned State counsel that the petitioner already stands convicted vide judgment of conviction dated 30.01.2020, in the instant FIR, i.e. before filing of the instant petition.

5. All pending application(s), if any, also stand **disposed** of accordingly.
