1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 21.08.2023 passed in CWP-12667-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Uma Shankar Gupta, Director, Directorate of Local Government, Punjab, filed in the Registry, is taken on record. Reply on behalf of respondent No.3 filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondents have submitted that the order dated 21.08.2023 passed in CWP-12667-2023 has since been complied with and speaking order dated 29.02.2024 has been passed and necessary payments have been made to the petitioner.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
