MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for release of the daughter of the petitioner from the alleged illegal custody of the private respondents.
2. Report has since been received from the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurdaspur, a perusal of which reveals that in compliance of order dated 31.01.2024, statement of the alleged detainee was recorded. The alleged detainee has categorically stated that she has not been kidnapped and has instead accompanied Navtej Singh of her own sweet will; she is happily living with Navtej Singh and wishes to continue living with him.

3. In the circumstances, nothing survives in the instant petition, which accordingly stands dismissed having been rendered infructuous.
