Challenge in the present petition is to the impugned stay orders dated 30.01.2024 (Annexures P-11 and P-12) passed by respondent No.4- District Registrar of Firms and Societies, Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that respondent No.4- District Registrar of Firms and Societies, Rohtak has been acting in league with one Rajender Bansal and that he has already filed an application for transferring the matters pending before respondent No.4- District Registrar of Firms and Societies, Rohtak namely Vijay Singh.

It is evident that the present case has been founded on an allegation of unholy nexus between the abovementioned Rajender Bansal and respondent No.4- District Registrar of Firms and Societies, Rohtak, however, neither of them has been impleaded as party in the present petition. In order to substantiate the allegations of malice, the person(s) against whom the allegations have been levelled, is/are required to be impleaded as party.

Learned counsel for the petitioner thus seeks withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action and with better particulars.

Disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty as aforesaid.

In the meanwhile, the respondent-State Registrar of Firms and Societies is directed to look into the pending application submitted by the petitioner seeking transfer of the cases from respondent No.4- District Registrar of Firms and Societies, Rohtak and to decide the representation (Annexure P-9) dated 23.01.2024 as expeditiously as possible.
