1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 CrPC is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to take action against the respondent No.4 by considering the representation dated 25.01.2024 (Annexure P-7) moved by the petitioner.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance of the order dated 05.02.2024, the respondent No.4 has been arrested and a case under Section 174-A IPC stands registered against him.
