NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order dated 29.04.1997 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Additional Registrar (C) Cooperative Societies, Punjab, Chandigarh, whereby the revision petition filed by respondent No.2 has been allowed by holding that since respondent No.2 has already been dismissed, therefore, second dismissal order is not in accordance with law.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after holding a departmental enquiry, respondent No.2 was dismissed from service vide order dated 08.08.1988 and his appeal and revision petition filed against the said order were also dismissed and thereafter, those

orders were challenged by him by filing CWP No.13737 of 1991 titled as ‘Gurtej Singh Vs. Additional Registrar Cooperative Societies, Punjab and others’ which was dismissed by this Court vide order dated 30.01.2024, upholding the dismissal of the petitioner from service.

3. Since the earlier dismissal of the petitioner has been upheld in CWP No.13737 of 1991, therefore, the instant writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
