1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India, read with Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 18.05.2023 passed in CM-8528-CWP-2023 in CWP-2931-2018.
2. Affidavit of Mohd. Faiyaz Farooqui, IPS, Additional Director General of Police, State Armed Police, Jalandhar, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 18.05.2023 passed in CM-8528-CWP-2023 in CWP-2931-2018 has been complied with and necessary speaking order dated 14.02.2024 has been passed. Copy of the order dated 14.02.2024, produced by the counsel for the respondent in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
