VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure praying for fair investigation in FIR No. 255 dated 30.10.2022, registered under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Pshychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga and FIR No. 10 dated 11.01.2023 registered under Sections 341, 324 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Dharmkot, District Moga.

2. Learned State counsel has submitted that as far as FIR No. 255 dated 30.10.2022 is concerned, report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been filed in the Court and thereafter, even charges have been framed and out of 14 witnesses, 4 have been examined. It is further submitted that as far as FIR No. 10 dated 11.01.2023 is concerned, report under Section 173

Cr.P.C. has to be prepared and the same would be submitted within a period of 3 weeks from today and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the abovesaid stand taken by the State, the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take up all the pleas which are available to her, in accordance with law, during the course of trial.

4. In view of the above, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
