1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to the official respondents No.2 to 6 to investigate the matter fairly in FIR No.141 dated 29.08.2023, under Sections 376D, 506 IPC, 1860 and Section 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, registered at Police Station Bichhore, District Nuh, Mewat, Haryana.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* contends that despite the facts that the FIR has been registered under Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012; the age of the minor victim is 14 years and her medical examination has been conducted; the Police has not taken any action against the private respondents. The FIR was registered on 29.08.2023 but till date, no arrest has been made and the petitioners have a threat to their life and liberty.
3. Learned State counsel has filed status report dated 16.05.2024, by way of affidavit of Sh. Ajaib Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, (HQ), Nuh, District Nuh, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 6, wherein, it has been confirmed



submitted that they are hiding at unknown locations. Raids were conducted on various dates and even the Investigating Agency has moved application for issuance of publication of the accused persons before the Court, which was fixed for 23.05.2024. It has further been confirmed that anticipatory bail moved by respondents No.7 and 8 has been dismissed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Nuh vide order dated 03.11.2023.

4. Learned State counsel confirms that appropriate action in the present FIR shall be taken within a period of 15 days from today.
5. In view of the undertaking given by the learned State counsel, the present petition stands disposed of. However, the State shall remain bound by the undertaking given by them.
6. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
