1. On 02.02.2024, the following order was passed:-

"1. Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks transfer of the investigation of FIR No.28 dated 21.06.2023, under Section 66-C of the Information Technology (Amendment) Act, 2008, registered at P.S. Dharamgarh, District Sangrur, to some senior police official/officer. In addition, the petitioner also seeks issuance of directions upon the respondent(s) concerned, to ensure protection of her life and liberty, at the hands of the private respondents concerned.

2. This Court deems it appropriate to, at this stage, without issuing notice, direct the learned State counsel to file a status report, detailing therein, the stage of investigation, and, the fact whether the threat perception, as alleged by the petitioners, genuinely exists or the same is based upon mere assumptions and presumptions.

3. List on 07.03.2024.

2. In pursuance of the above said order, a status report by way of affidavit dated 22.03.2024 of Sh. Prithvi Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of

Police, Sub Division, Dirba, has been filed on behalf of respondent-State. The same is taken on record.

3. Upon perusal of the reply, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is satisfied with the pace of the investigation, and at this stage, the grievance of the petitioner has been redressed.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that a mandamus may be passed upon the official respondent, to conclude the investigation in a time bound manner.
5. The submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner is declined, at this stage, as this Court do not find any inordinate delay in conclusion of the investigation.
6. The instant petition is **disposed** of accordingly.
