VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to sit in his B.Tech (CSE) examinations.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 have jointly submitted that the main writ petition has been rendered infructuous and learned counsel for the petitioner has filed an application bearing No.CM-6420-CWP-2024 for withdrawal of the present Civil Writ Petition.
