1. Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to the official respondents No.2 and 3 for initiation of appropriate action against the private respondents on the basis of representation dated 29.08.2023 (Annexure P-6), filed on behalf of the petitioner.
2. As per short reply dated 18.07.2024, S.P.(PBI), Fatehgarh Sahib had conducted the investigation in the matter and submitted an inquiry report dated 29.01.2024 (Annexure R-2/T).
3. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the relevant documents.



4. As per the inquiry report (Annexure R-2/T), application dated 17.10.2023 moved by Paramjit Kaur wife of Gurjinder Singh and another application dated 21.11.2023 moved by Karamjit Kaur daughter of Gurbaksh Singh have been decided. There is no reference about the representation dated 29.08.2023 (Annexure P-6) moved by the petitioner.
5. In view of the said circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondents to decide the representation dated 29.08.2023 (Annexure P-6), filed on behalf of the petitioner, within a period of one month on receipt of certified copy of this order.
6. State is at liberty to take appropriate action as per law, in case any cognizable offence is made out.
7. All pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stands disposed of.
