This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 23.05.2016 passed by this Court in CM-6111-CWP-2016 in CWP-6654-2016.

There is nothing on record to show that the respondents have recovered any amount, which was already paid to the petitioner. The petitioner might be having some other grievances regarding non-release of certain retiral benefits, however, the said entitlement cannot be determined in the contempt proceedings. Hence, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
