KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)

State counsel on instructions from Gurbaksh Singh official of DC Office, Amritsar submits that on the last date of hearing, this Court directed that alleged detenue-Arshpreet Kaur daughter of the petitioner be lodged in Government shelter home in Amritsar. It is further submitted that Arshpreet Kaur showed her willingness to accompany her mother and as such, she was permitted to do so and presently, Arshpreet Kaur is residing with her mother in her parental house. State counsel further submits that as per inquiry conducted by District Administration, Arshpreet Kaur is minor being born on 10.11.2006 and he produced concerned inquiry report which is taken on record. State counsel further submits that as of now, as Arshpreet Kaur is living with her mother, present petition deserves to be disposed of. Even the counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.4 and

5 submits that the present petition be disposed of in light of the aforesaid

statement made by the State counsel.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that admittedly, Arshpreet Kaur is now happily residing with the petitioner and the petitioner and Arshpreet Kaur are at liberty to take action against Gurwinder Singh-respondent No.4 and any other person who lured Arshpreet Kaur to leave her parental house.

3. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the present petition be disposed of in light of the submissions made by the State counsel.

4. Ordered accordingly.
