HARPREET KAUR JEEWAN, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of FIR No.627 dated 21.08.2022 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 323, 34, 354, 354-A, 377, 498-A, 506 IPC, 1860, Sections 34, 354, 354-A IPC deleted in the challan dated 23.12.2022 (Annexure P-2), registered at Police Station Hansi City, District Hisar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise deed dated 04.01.2024 (Annexure P-3), executed between the parties.
2. This Court, vide order dated 05.02.2024, had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.
3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, the parties have appeared before the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Hansi and got their statements recorded. On the



dated 16.05.2024 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence. The petitioner has not been declared as “Proclaimed Offender” and he is not involved in any other criminal case.

4. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant F.I.R.

6. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in “Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007” (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052 and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in “Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others” (2012) 10 SCC 303, this petition is allowed and FIR No.627 dated 21.08.2022 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 323, 34, 354, 354-A, 377, 498-A, 506 IPC, 1860, Sections 34, 354, 354-A IPC deleted in the challan dated 23.12.2022 (Annexure P-2), registered at Police Station Hansi City, District Hisar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are ordered to be quashed qua the petitioner.

7. However, the respondent No.2 and the State shall be at liberty to seek cancellation of this order, in case the final terms and conditions of compromise deed dated 04.01.2024 (Annexure P-3) are violated.

8. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
