3. I have considered the submissions and find that the District Education Officer (Secondary Education) has also conducted an inquiry and find that the petitioner's attitude is not appropriate towards the staff. The atmosphere of the school is being disturbed because of one employee. She

has been found to be threatening the other teachers of the school and, therefore, the District Education Officer has recommended to transfer the petitioner to some other school.

4. It is noticed that a charge sheet was also issued to the petitioner by the District Education Officer for spoiling the atmosphere of the school as well as charging excess fees from the students. An inquiry under Rule 8 of the Punjab Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 1970, has also been initiated against the petitioner.

5. In view thereof, the transfer of the petitioner from one school to another school in the same district cannot be said to be in any manner wrongful, rather, it would be appropriate as a departmental inquiry is being initiated against the petitioner and she should be kept away from interfering with the record of the school.

6. The writ petition is devoid of merit and is accordingly dismissed.

7. All pending misc. application(s) also stand disposed of.
