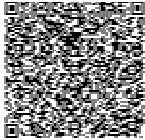

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 03.01.1997 (Annexure P-6) whereby Labour Court has allowed application under Section 33-C(2) of Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (for short 'ID Act').
