Prayer in the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the official respondents Nos. 2 and 3 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners and not to interfere in the peaceful life of the petitioners.

Status report filed by way of an affidavit of Ms. Kanwardeep Kaur, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T. Chandigarh on behalf of respondent No.1-U.T. Chandigarh has been received and recorded as under:-

“1. That in compliance of Order dated 05.02.2024 passed by this Hon'ble Court, on 05.02.2024 investigation was done with regard to the genuineness and veracity of the allegations leveled in the representation at Annexure P-5 and with regard to threat perception to the life and liberty of petitioner. During investigation the petitioners were recorded their respective statements. In their Chandigarh statement both the petitioners have stated that now petitioners are living happily as husband-wife at H.No.2677, Sector-52, Chandigarh after solemnizing their marriage and

while residing at the given address they have no difficulty and there is no threat perception to them from anyone. The true translated copies of the statements of Petitioner No.1 & 2 are attached herewith **as Annexure A-1 & A-2 respectively**. It is pertinent to mention here that during inquiry the owner Sunil Kumar S/o Ram Murat of H. No. 2677, Sector-52, Chandigarh met police officials and got recorded his statement on 06.02.2024 that he has given one room set on rent @ Rs.3200/- per month to the petitioners on 31.01.2024 and got prepared a rent agreement. He further stated that both the petitioner introduced as husband wife to him. A copy of the statement of the Sunil Kumar is attached herewith as **Annexure R-3**.

2. That during investigation it was found that after solemnizing the marriage both the petitioners are now living happily as husband wife at H. No. 2677, Sector 52, Chandigarh. That in view of the statements of both petitioners at Annexure A-1 & A-2 there is no threat to them from anyone, therefore, the present matter become infructuous.”

In view of the status report, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and dismissed as such.
