The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for the issuance of directions to the Sessions Judge, Kapurthala in case FIR No.106 dated 17.10.2019 under Sections 302, 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (added later on vide GD No.15 dated 19.10.2019) to expedite the Trial and to conclude the same within a period of 06 months.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that despite the FIR having been registered on 17.10.2019, only 03 of the 32 prosecution witnesses have been examined so far and therefore, appropriate directions be issued to the Trial Court to conclude the Trial as expeditiously as possible.
