Prayer in the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the official respondents Nos. 2 and 3 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners and not to interfere in the peaceful life of the petitioners.

Reply by way of an affidavit of Shashank Kumar Sawan, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Karnal on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3 has been taken on record, recorded as follows:-

“1. That 09.02.2024 (Annexure P-5) representation was received in the office of a deponent on the same day it was marked to SHO Indri to look into the matter and submit his report qua the threat perception to the petitioners, a report received from SHO Indri that he had joined both the petitioners and their joint statement was recorded. That in their joint statement, they clearly stated that they are living happily and this marriage has been solemnized with their own sweet will. Now, their family members have accepted

this relationship, and they do not require any police protection from their family members.

2. That at present, as per the report submitted by SHO Indri, both the petitioners are residing in District Yamuna Nagar and living happy married life and do not need any police protection from any of the family members. They do not have any apprehension of threats from family members. Moreover, they promised the SHO Indri to appear before this Hon’ble High Court on the date fixed, i.e. 13.02.2024, in this regard.”

In view of the reply, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is dismissed as such.
