The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.265 dated 16.12.2023, under Sections 22 and 81 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (Section 29 of the NPDS Act added later on), registered at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur.

This Court vide order dated 05.02.2024, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 05.02.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harbhajan Singh, does not controvert the said fact and further submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above, the order dated 05.02.2024 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
