Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.67 dated 25.03.2023 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Division No.5, District Ludhiana.

The allegations in nutshell are that petitioner, a private person took Rs.4,000/- from the complainant Vijay Kumar on the pretext of getting done work from Tehsil office, Ludhiana.

On the last date of hearing, a detailed order was passed whereby the petitioner was granted interim bail with a direction to join the investigation with the police subject to deposit of Rs.4,000/- with the Illaqa Magistrate concerned.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner brought to the notice of this Court that the petitioner has complied with the aforesaid interim order and joined the investigation with the police and further deposited an amount of Rs.4,000/- with the concerned Court.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Balkaran Singh submits that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and

also deposited Rs.4,000/- with the concerned Court and further submits that now the petitioner is not required for any further investigation or custodial interrogation by the police.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 05.02.2024 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.However, the aforesaid deposit of Rs.4,000/- will subject to the final decision of the Trial Court.
