1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of mandamus, directing the respondent-Corporation to make payment of arrears of pay revision amounting to Rs.52,359/- consequent upon implementation of the 4th Pay Commission Report for the period from 01.01.1996 to the date of retirement of the petitioner i.e. 30.11.1998 along with interest @ 12% per annum.
2. Mr. T.S. Sidhu, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent and filed memo of appearance, which is taken on record.
3. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has unfortunately died on 12.06.2023. However, no LRs have been brought on record.
4. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to the LRs of the deceased-petitioner to revive the present petition, in case any cause still survives.
