1. Instant petition under Section 482 Cr.PC has been preferred seeking directions to the respondents to complete the investigation in case FIR (Annexure P-14) as under: -

2. Heard.

3. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has moved various representations to the respondent-authorities for taking appropriate legal action against the culprits but no action has been taken on the said representations.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that even series of representations have been moved, the latest being

Annexure P-17 dated 17.10.2023 moved to the Superintendent of Police, Rewari, but no action has been taken on the said representation.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 3 to consider and dispose of the representation (Annexure P-17) in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

6. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

7. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Surender Singh, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 4.

8. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 3-Superintendent of Police, Rewari, Haryana, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 17.10.2023 (Annexure P-17), to dispose of the same expeditiously preferably within a period of three months and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.

9. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
