Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present petition, grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner has not been granted benefit of 1st, 2nd and 3rd ACP on completion of satisfactory service of 08, 16 and 24 years, which service was completed in the years 2004, 2012 and 2020 respectively and hence, the respondents are under an obligation to grant the petitioner said benefit of ACP along with consequential relief.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of serving a legal notice dated 11.12.2023 (Annexure P/6), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the

respondent-State and submits that in case legal notice dated 11.12.2023 (Annexure P/6) has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the respondents, the same will be decided by the respondents in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
