1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 08.08.2023 passed in CWP-30906-2018.
2. Short reply by way of affidavit of Ashwani Kumar Dogra, General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Ambala, filed in the Registry, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 08.08.2023 passed in CWP-30906-2018 has since been complied with and necessary payments have been made to the petitioner. Photocopy of invoice to that effect, has been filed by the counsel for the respondents in the Court today. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
