1. The present petition has been filed only after the petitioner came to know about the atrocities being met out to the child by the father.
2. After arguing vehemently on the merits of the case, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to approach the Court of competent jurisdiction by invoking the provisions under the Guardianship and Wards Act, 1956.
3. In light of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
4. In case, the petitioner approaches the Court of competent jurisdiction the same shall be looked into in accordance with law.
5. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case and the liberty granted, if any, is only on the request of the counsel for the petitioner and is not a direction.
6. It is further made clear that filing or pendency of this petition or any order/direction passed in this petition shall not be an *alibi* or defence to the petitioner, in case, she is found involved in any illegal activity and the respondent-Authorities shall take appropriate action, in accordance with law.
