NAMIT KUMAR, J.

1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of *certiorari* setting aside the charge sheet No.2546 dated 10.02.2022 (Annexure P-3) and charge sheet No.3632 dated 24.06.2022 (Annexure P-4) pending post-retirement of the petitioner and for issuance of directions to the respondent to release the retiral benefits of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for claiming retiral dues, petitioner has already submitted representation dated 05.07.2023 (Annexure P-5) and he may be given liberty to supplement the said representation by filing a fresh representation within a period of two weeks and the same may be considered and decided by the respondent in a time-bound manner.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record of the case.

4. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition, the respondent is directed to consider and decide the claim made in the representation dated 05.07.2023 and supplementary representation, if any moved by the petitioner, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of said representation.

5. The petition stands disposed of.
