1. Instant petition under Section 482 Cr.PC has been preferred seeking directions to the official respondents No. 2 and 3 to hand over the investigation of the FIR (Annexure P-1) to some other independent investigating agency (SIT) or Crime Branch, Chandigarh. The details of the FIR are as under: -

2. Heard.

3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent citizen, having no concern with the alleged FIR (*supra*), but the local police is trying to implicate him in the said

case. He further submits that in this regard, the petitioner has even moved a representation dated 18.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) before the Superintendent of Police, District Jhajjar, but no action has been taken thereon.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2 to consider and dispose of the representation (Annexure P-2) in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

5. Notice of motion.

6. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Surender Singh, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents.

7. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2-Superintendent of Police, District Jhajjar, Haryana to consider the averments made in the representation dated 18.01.2024 (Annexure P-2), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.

8. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
