By way of present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.69 dated 14.05.2023 registered at Police Station Kot Isse Khan, District Moga under Sections 401/379/411/420/465/467/468/471/473/120-B IPC.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that four of the co-accused, namely, Parwinder Singh, Gursewak Singh @ Sewak, Jasjit Singh @ Bhalla and Kewal Singh have already been allowed bail by this Court vide a common order dated 18.01.2024 (Annexure P.2) passed in CRM-M-38110 of 2023, CRM-M-52634 of 2023, CRM-M-43085 of 2023 and CRM-M-41588 of 2023. Learned counsel further contends that case of the petitioner is on parity with them.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Karunesh Kaushal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent- State.

Learned State Counsel could not refute the afore-said contentions.

On instructions from ASI Gurmail Singh, it is conceded by learned State Counsel

that case of the petitioner is on parity with the co-accused, who have already been allowed bail.

Custody certificate placed on record also reveals that petitioner is in custody for the last 08 months and 27 days. Trial may take time to conclude.

Having regard to all the afore-said facts and circumstances of the case, particularly on the basis of parity, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, present petition is allowed. Petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/ Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and condtions.
