1. Status report, by way of affidavit of Ajay Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Sri Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar has been filed by learned State counsel in the Court today and the same is taken on record. Para 15 thereof reads as under:

*“That vide the present petition, the petitioner has prayed for quashing of FIR No.70 dated 02.08.2009. It is relevant to mention here that after looking into the case it comes out that present petitioner has no role to play as per enquiry report which is on record, which shows there is no involvement of the petitioner in the commission of the offences of the present case/FIR.”*
