1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 06.05.2022 passed in CWP-9455-2022.
2. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 06.05.2022 passed in CWP-9455-2022 has been complied with and the representation of the petitioner has been decided. The petitioner has been promoted to the post of TGT Sanskrit. Copy of order dated 08.05.2024, produced by the counsel for the respondents in the Court today, is taken on record.
