1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of order dated 16.11.2021 passed by this Court in CWP-23223-2021.
2. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.
3. Short reply by way of affidavit of Rameshwar Dass, Superintending Engineer, on behalf of the respondents has been filed by learned counsel for the respondents today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that order dated 16.11.2021 passed by this Court in CWP-23223-2021 has been complied with and speaking order has been passed. As per the said speaking order, representation moved by the petitioner stands decided and the petitioner has been found entitled to the benefits.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
