VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari or any other appropriate writ, order or direction for quashing the impugned order dated 28.10.2096 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Telecommunication, Haryana vide which the claim of the petitioner for promotion to the rank of Head Constable w.e.f. 25.12.2092 i.e. from the date when juniors to the petitioner were promoted has been rejected.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he is not in touch with the petitioner and thus, the present petition be disposed of as infructuous at this stage. He further submits that liberty be granted to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the present petition, in case any cause survives.
3. In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, at this stage. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the same in case any cause survives.
