1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.771 dated 08.11.2023 under Sections 406, 420 of the IPC registered at Police Station Shahbad, District Kurukshetra.

2. Learned counsel for the parties have informed the Court that the matter stands amicably settled between the parties. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant submits that he would not oppose the prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner for being extended the concession of anticipatory bail.
