1. The learned State counsel submits, that the Mining Officer, Sub Division Derabassi, District Mohali, on the basis of the relevant complaint, would proceed to after conducting a fresh demarcation of the disputed sites, thus take lawful actions against the errant(s) concerned.
2. In view of the above, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks, and, is permitted to withdraw the instant petition. Ordered accordingly.
3. However, it is clarified, that the mining officer concerned, seized with the relevant complaint, shall ensure that after his becoming possessed with the fresh demarcation of the disputed lands, that he proceeds to take further lawful action, as deemed fit, in terms of the relevant rules against the errant(s) concerned.
