1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.91 dated 18.12.2023 under Sections 323, 325, 427, 34, 452 of IPC, Police Station Singh Bhagwantpur, District Rupnagar.
2. As per the allegations recorded in the FIR, one Hardeep Singh accompanied by one unknown person caused injuries to complainant Jagdeep Singh.
3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was not named in the FIR and even otherwise only simple injuries are attributed to the accomplice of main accused Hardeep Singh. It is further submitted that in compliance of the previous order, petitioner Gagandeep Singh has joined investigation with the police.

4. The State counsel on instructions from HC Sandeep Kumar has not refuted the aforesaid contentions raised by the counsel for the petitioner. The State counsel further submits that petitioner who has already joined investigation with the police is not required for any further investigation in the present case by the police. The State counsel further apprised the Court that only simple injuries are attributed to the petitioner and weapon used in commission of crime is recovered at the instance of the petitioner.
5. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 05.02.2024 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
